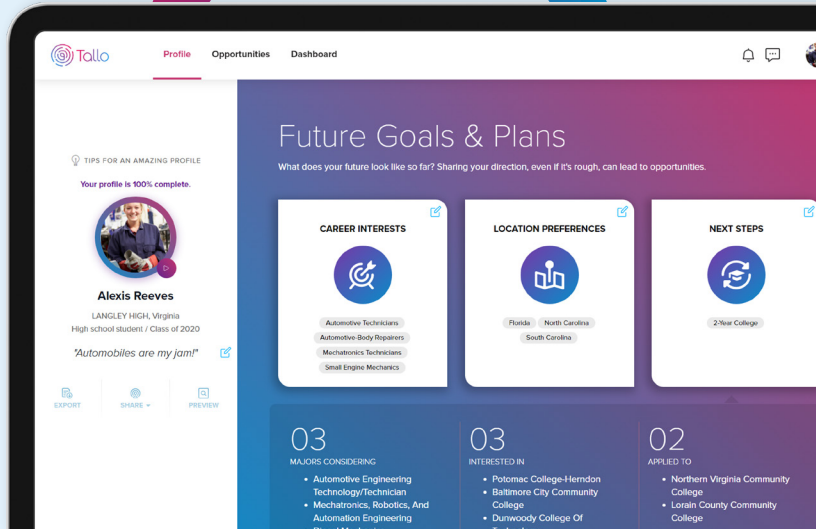


Student conferences

A student-driven self-assessment exercise.



OBJECTIVES

- Provide precise and targeted feedback on the content in a student’s Tallo profile.
- Students leave with actionable steps to enhance their Tallo profiles.

TIPS

Students should share their Tallo profile with their teacher so it’s easily accessible during the conference. Profiles should be at least 85% complete (this information comes from the student dashboard).



MATERIALS

- Student Self-Assessment Handout
- Student Conference Sheet



TIMELINES

- Prepare for conferences throughout the school year.
- Quarter classes: Have a conference at the beginning of the school year and another around week 8 or 9.
- Semester classes: Have a conference after 45 days and another at the end of the semester.
- Full year classes: Have a conference every 9 weeks.
- Students should spend 15 minutes completing the Self-Reflection Handout
- The student-teacher conference should last about 10-15 minutes.



LOG INTO TALLO TO ANSWER THESE QUESTIONS

- What career would you like to pursue?
- Do you need any additional education to achieve this career goal? If so, explain.
- What classes have you taken or could you take that can help prepare you for this field?

TIP

Make sure your profile is shared with your teacher. Click Share from the top of your Tallo profile then Share with Mentor or Parent. Type in your teacher's email address to share your profile with them.
